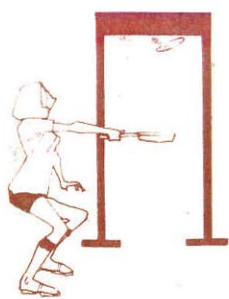

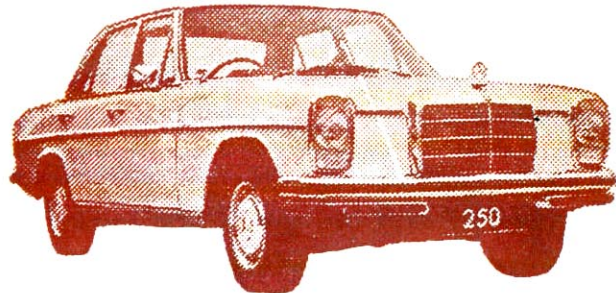

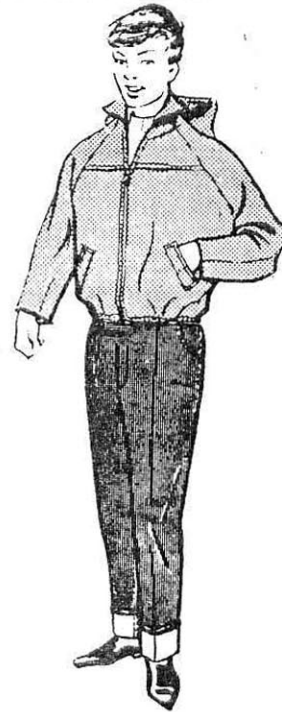

EDDIE WARING, commentator

B.B.C. tv's inimitable Rugby League commentator has been associated with "It's a Knockout!" since 1966. As a referee, he has been a referee on the show.

Eddie has been in television ever since it started in the 1950s and the B.B.C.'s Rugby League coverage grew to become television's finest regular outside broadcasts. He has covered the Rugby League Challenge Cup Final from Wembley since then.

Born in Dewsbury in the West Riding of Yorkshire, he played Rugby Union, Rugby League – and was a wrestler too.

Something of a globe trotter, he has made seven trips round the world and appeared on television in Australia, New Zealand, and the United States.

Eddie usually gives a special blow-by-blow account of the mini-marathon contest which can be the vital tie-breaker in a tight game.

STUART HALL, commentator

Stuart Hall, who will be making his debut in the Exeter-Salisbury game, "It's a Knockout!" currently presents "Look North," the B.B.C. North West nightly magazine programme in Manchester, makes frequent appearances on "Nationwide," and is the cheery questionmaster of "Quiz Ball."

Stuart, born in greater Manchester, first broadcast in 1958 as a contributor to the Northern radio programme "Sports Spotlight." He has reported on soccer, cricket, tennis, motor racing and motor cycling as well as current affairs for television and radio.

Football, fast cars and antique clocks are his great love. As a teenager, he played soccer as an amateur for Lancashire, Derbyshire and Crystal Palace.

Behind the steering wheel, he once roared round Oulton Park and Silverstone in an Elva-Climax and an Austin Healey. But he never won a race! Best performance: second!

Married the same year he started broadcasting – 1958 – he has two children, Francesca, 12, and Daniel, 10. His home in Glossop, Derbyshire, is crammed with antique clocks, Victorian furniture, bronzes and old portraits.

He sees "It's a Knockout!" as essentially a "fun show" and is determined to make it as entertaining as possible for competitors and viewers.

ARTHUR ELLIS, referee

Arthur Ellis must rank as one of the best known soccer referees in the world today. Over the years, he has officiated in practically every country that plays first class football.

He has refereed World Cup ties and 73 internationals in his time, and became the first English referee to be awarded the Gold Badge of F.I.F.A.

He now works as a brewery representative and lives in Halifax in his native Yorkshire.

His function today as always, is to see fair play on both sides as he tots up the scores.
