Arthur Ellis must rank as one of the best known soccer referees in the world today. Over the years, he has officiated in practically every country that plays first class football.

He has referred World Cup ties and 73 internationals in his time, and became the first English referred to be awarded the Gold Badge of F.I.F.A.

He now works as a brewery representative and lives in Halifax in his native Yorkshire.
