

AROUND THE WORLD IN 80 MINUTES IN THE FUTURE

ROWND Y BYD MEWN 80 MUNUD YN Y DYFODOL

Thema'r rhaglen yw 'Rownd y Byd Mewn 80 Munud yn y Dyfodol', ac mae wedi ei seilio ar nofel Jules Verne, 'Around the World in 80 Days', a gyhoeddwyd ym 1873.

Mae'r daith yn dechrau yng Nghaerdydd (nid Llundain), ac fel yn y nofel bydd gêmau'n mynd â'r timau i Baris, yr Eidal, yr Aifft, India, Hong Kong, Siapan, San Ffransisco ac Efrog Newydd cyn cychwelyd i Gaerdydd. Nia Chiswell ac Iestyn Garlick, sydd bellach ar eu pedwaredd gyfres o **Gêmau Heb Ffiniau**, fydd yn cyflwyno.

The theme of our programme is "Around the World in 80 Minutes in the Future" based on the novel written by Jules Verne in 1873 - "Around the World in Eighty Days".

Jules Verne is known as the father of science-fiction and many of his ideas have become reality.


The story tells of the voyage around the world made by Phileas Fogg and his manservant Passepartout after having bet £20,000 that such a journey could be competed in 80 days, with his friends in his London Club. Here is the itinerary of the journey.

In our programme we will try to go around the world in 80 minutes but imagining the world in the future.

Our presenters Nia and lestyn represent descendants of Fogg and Aouda, the woman who became his wife at the end of the novel. Our other presenter, Johnny Tudor, responsible for the jokers and the bets, represents Passepartout, Phileas Fogg's manservant.

Nia and lestyn will voyage in a large spaceship which will be used in the future for such cruises very much like our cruise ships today. Just like today's cruise ships, on board this space ship there is a band which plays during the evening, and a casino where the jokers and bets will be presented.
